



EXCURSION 1 - LILLAFÜRED TOUR

Museum of Metallurgy – Miskolc-Felsőhámor

The Museum of Metallurgy is situated in the picturesque valley of Szinva Creek. The permanent exhibition of the museum is hosted by the wonderful 18th-centruy Baroque building of Chancellery in Miskolc-Felsőhámor, displaying the Hungarian and world history of iron metallurgy from the Ancient Times till the end of the 20th century. The history of iron metallurgy can be seen in chronological order in terms of technology. Several unique objects are included in the permanent exhibition: two bloomery furnaces from the 10-12th century, displayed in their original place and condition and the world-famous steel engraver, used during the regulation of the river Danube.

Massa Museum – Miskolc-Újmassa)

The Massa Museum which belongs to the Museum of Metallurgy welcomes its visitors in the valley of Garadna Creek. It exhibits the main events of the hundred-year-old history of iron metallurgy of Diósgyőr, its original documents, instruments, and products, which were used in the 18th and 19th centuries. One of the most significant national industrial monuments stands next to the museum, namely the blast furnace, built in the 18th century and fired by charcoal, which is known as the "Fazola smelter". The surroundings of the "iron beater" ('hámor') is usually loud from the beats of the great hammer - in the building, which is reconstructed based or eighteen-century-drawings, a water-wheel driven wolf hammer, a wind bag and a glowing furnace recall the spirit of the contemporary workhouse. On the other bank of the brook, in a national monument area, there is an open-air museum of machines applied in iron metallurgy and mining. Here

Lillafüred and Castle of Diósgyőr – Miskolc

Lillafüred, where fresh air and adventures are being highly concentrated. Only 15 km away from Miskolc you can find one of the most beautiful hotels of Hungary, the picturesque Hámori Lake and the hanging garden, where our poet, Attila József was inspired by the wonderful landscape.

Walking around in Lillafüred you can find attractions in every 10 minutes, such as Otto Hermann Memorial House, DVTK Sport and Adventure Park and the nearly 1 km long Chair-lift, which was inaugurated this spring. These are all surrounded by the magnifique ridges of Bükk Mountain. The Diósgyőr Castle is a medieval castle in the historical town of Diósgyőr which is now part of the Northern Hungarian city Miskolc. The first Diósgyőr Castle was built probably in the 12th century and was destroyed during the Mongol invasion (1241–42). The current, Gothic castle was built after the invasion and reached the peak of its importance during the reign of King Louis the Great (1342-1382). Later it became a wedding gift for the queens of Hungary, which it remained until the Ottoman invasion of Hungary in the 16th century. By the end of the 17th century it was already in ruins. Archaeological excavations started in the 1960s. In 2014 the castle was completely rebuilt, the reconstructed rooms are furnished with Mediaeval-style furniture.

Program

First we will visit the Museum of Metallurgy in Felsőhámor. After getting an English tour in the museum participants can walk around in the picturesque Lillafüred with the Hotel Palota, the famous waterfall, hanging gardens and Lake Hámor. With the bus around 1 PM we continue our ride up in the Bükk Mountain to reach Újmassa where the stuff of the Museum of Metallurgy and Massa Museum will cook a typical Hungarian dishes, "pörkölt" in open air for us. Tasting and buying traditional Hungarian wine will be also possible. After lunch we will visit the Massa museum and the skanzen.

On our way home we will stop at the Castle of Diósgyör where with an English guide you get the chance to visit this rebuild castle.

We plan our arrival back to Miskolc around 7 PM.
